The meeting was called to order at 6:00 PM by Mr. Jeff Stumbo. Let the record show that the following board members were present at this meeting: Mr. Jeff Stumbo, Ms. Linda Gearheart, Ms. Rhonda Meade, and Ms. Sherry Robinson. Dr. Chandra Varia was not present at this meeting. Also present at this meeting was Mr. Henry Webb, Superintendent.

ORDER NO. 17555

Secretary II Position (Item 2)

Ms. Meade made the motion and Ms. Gearheart seconded the motion to approve the proposal to reclassify the Dispatcher position currently at the Department of Transportation to a Secretary II position.

There was an affirmative vote by all board members present to approve the motion. The motion carried.

KRS 162.90 Powers and Duties of the local board. If enacted, this proposal would result in a salary savings of approximately \$3,518.00, the difference being the amount that was last disbursed for the dispatcher position and the salary level for a Secretary II at zero years of experience. At the Transportation Department, the duties of the Dispatcher can easily be handled by a Secretary II. Also, it allows for the new Secretary II to do duties above and beyond of those of a Dispatcher. This approach will also reduce department disruptions at the offices and allow for increased productivity.

2012-2013 Tax Rate (Item 3)

Mr. Stumbo made the motion and Ms. Meade seconded the motion to approve adopting the property tax rate of 52.0 cents per \$100 of assessed value for both real and personal property for the 2012-2013 Tax Year.

There was an affirmative vote by all board members present to approve the motion. The motion carried.

KRS 160.470; KRS 157.440; KRS 157.620; KRS 132.0225; KAR 3:275. Annually the Board must adopt property tax rates. A review of the

assessments for the 2012-2013 tax year shows that the total assessment has increased enough to permit a levy of the same cents per hundred as tax year 2011-2012. This means that more taxable property is available to generate just under the 4% increase in revenue without increasing the tax rate per \$100 of property assessment. Approve the tax rate of 52.0 cents per \$100 for Real Property and 52.0 cents per hundred for Personal Property. Rates as listed provide needed revenue to the general fund and to the FSPK Building fund.
